HALE NA'AU PONO DEMOGRAPHIC BREAKDOWN

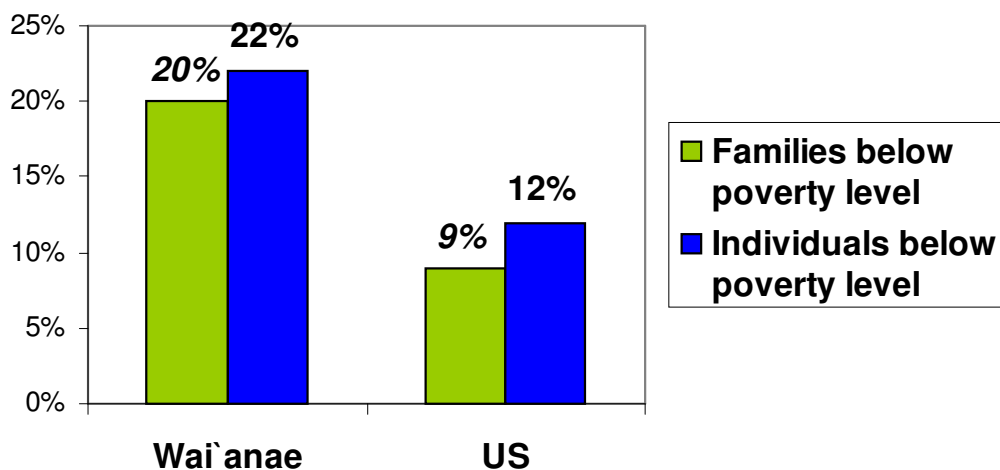

Basic demographics of the community we serve:

Data from US Census 2000 - WAI'ANAE

- Population is approximately 42,000 in zip code 96792
- 29% are Native Hawaiians
- 71% consist of other prominent ethnic groups such as: Filipino, Caucasian, Samoan, Japanese, Chinese, Korean, Puerto Rican, Vietnamese and others.
- 45% of Wai'anae's population is less than 20 years old
- 20% of families are below poverty level
- 22% of individuals are below poverty level
- 20% have disability status

US Census 2000 Below Poverty Level



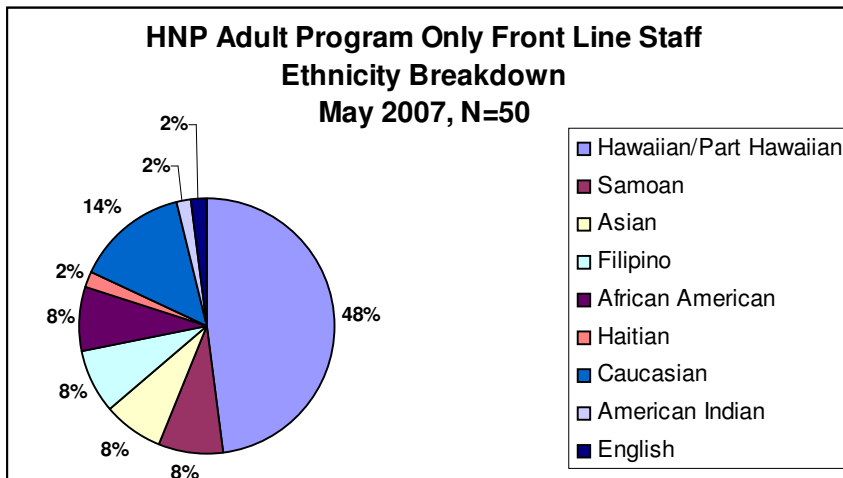

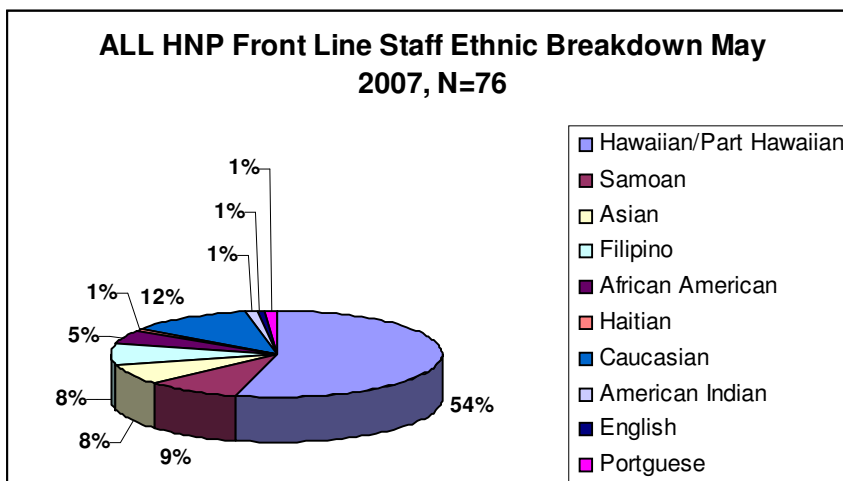
Hale Na'au Pono ethnic breakdown of line staff who provides direct services to consumers

The target population of our community mental health and/or health programs

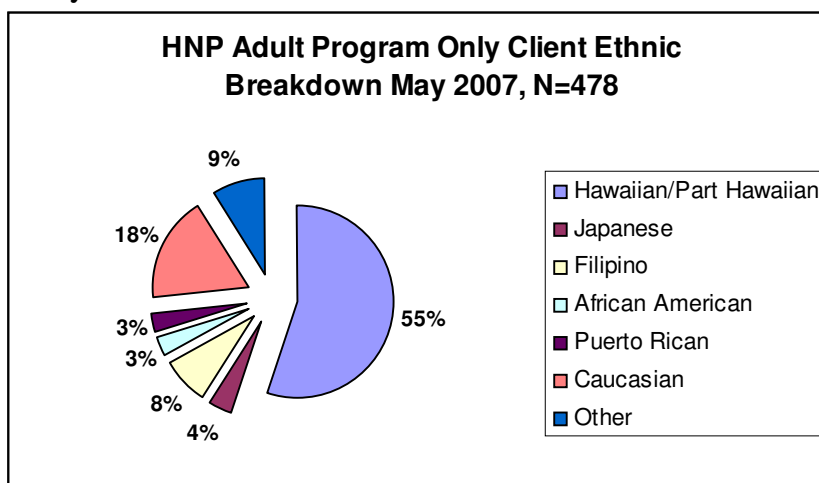
Hale Na'au Pono target population are Serious Mentally Ill (SMI) adults and youth from ages 5 and up; all ethnicities. Wai'anae Neighborhood Place, a program within HNP, serves families in crisis along the Wai'anae Coast. Ho'okaulike, Hale Na'au Pono's substance abuse and treatment program, serves adults 18 years and older in Pre-contemplative, Outpatient, and Aftercare services while incorporating traditional Hawaiian values in treatment.

Ethnicity breakdown of Hale Na'au Pono consumers in 2007



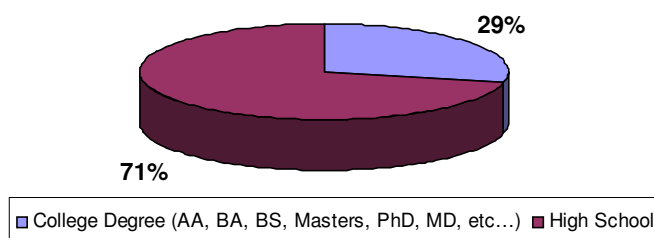
